AN UMPIRE'S PRE-GAME ACTIVITIES

1. 1-2 days prior to game:

- a. Call or email the school A.D. or head coach to confirm location and time of game
- b. Call your partner: Determine who has the plate; Agree where to park; get partner's car info, etc.
- c. Procedure if inclement weather
- d. Always have your partner's cell number with you.

2. Day of game

- a. Arrive 30 40 minutes prior to start time
- b. Check in with home team coach at field
- c. Observe any special or possibly hazardous field conditions
- d. Park next to your partner if he gets there first!

3. Pre-game meeting with partner (in parking lot)

- a. Rules review latest changes, special concerns/questions
- b. Field coverage
 - i. Fair/foul responsibilities
 - ii. Fly ball coverage; responsibilities if BU goes out
 - iii. Trapped balls
 - iv. Ground ball responsibilities
 - v. Tag-ups
 - vi. Missed bases
 - vii. Infield fly
 - viii. PU covering third base; helping out at 1 base
 - ix. Pivot play at 2nd base in double play situation
 - x. Check swings
 - xi. Batted ball hitting batter while in box
 - xii, Rundowns
- c. Game situations
 - i. Hand signals and other non-verbal communications
 - ii. Verbal communications in coverage situations
 - iii. Dealing with benches
 - iv. Inclement weather/darkness
 - v. Unique ground rules or conditions specific to field
 - vi. Past problems with coaches/players; history between teams

4. Pre-game meeting with head coaches at home plate

- a. Enter field approximately 10 minutes prior to game time
- b. Insure team not warming up is in dugout or bullpen
- c. SOFTBALL ONLY: Check for illegal or unsafe equipment.
- d. Get sufficient number of balls
- e. Pre-game meeting with coaches/captains
 - i. Introductions
 - ii. Exchange of lineup cards; check for obvious errors, omissions, etc.
 - iii. Ask if all substitutes' names are listed on the line cards
 - iv. Announcement of ground rules by HC, or PU if he knows them
 - v, Verify that players are properly equipped
 - vi. Emphasize that all participants are expected to exhibit good sportsmanship throughout the game
 - vii. Ask coaches for "any questions or concerns?"
